SPECIAL AND EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES.

Plaintiff moves this court to a lawful order to be acted upon with prejudice along with an Emergency Injunction to be served upon actors of Name of Hospital (referred to as "Accused" hereafter) for a reprieve from an unlawful quarantine of a virus that has never been lawfully isolated.

The demand for the Emergency Injunction is to restore the Constitutionally protected rights of Plaintiff and his lawful offspring and to find proper medical care for his biological property.

The Accused has knowingly and willingly continued to bully, coerce and induce mass undue stress through their unlawful acts.

Plaintiff states they shall and will be irreparably harmed without an Emergency Injunction. Plaintiff further states that the Court must enter an Emergency Injunction to prevent further ongoing harm and injury to Plaintiff's biological property, First Middle Last Name and demands the process of having his Constitutionally protected property rights restored.
